


Family Medicine State Fact Sheet in Alabama





No other medical specialty covers the broad range of primary care services that family medicine does.

Family medicine is based on a philosophy of caring for the whole person and a continual emphasis on family, community and environmental context, making it the ideal specialty to care for America's most vulnerable and underserved communities.


Family Physician Shortage in Alabama

Alabama currently has 1,520 family physicians but needs 2,430 for an adequate level of services.8
